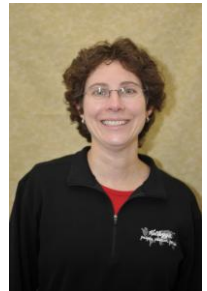
## March's All-Member Meeting *Successful Women Panel Discussion*
